

COOKIES POLICY

We collect the information we mentioned in the previous paragraphs through the use of various technologies, including one called "cookies". A cookie is a piece of data that a Web site can send to your browser, which may then be stored on your computer as an anonymous tag that identifies your computer but not you. You can set your browser to notify you before you receive a cookie, giving you the chance to decide whether to accept it. You can also set your browser to turn off cookies. If you do so, however, some site pages may not work properly.

Categories of cookies

The cookies used on our site are divided into four categories:

1. ABSOLUTELY NECESSARY COOKIES

The absolutely necessary cookies are essential for the proper functioning of the site. Without these, you might not be able to browse and use all the functions of the site and, therefore, without these cookies, we cannot offer you an efficient operation of our website. These cookies do not recognize your individual identity.

2. USABILITY COOKIES

The usability cookies store user data that affect heavily the operation of the site and facilitate the user's next visit to the website. The data can be anonymous, and are not available during the user's navigation to other sites.

3. STATISTICS COOKIES

These cookies collect information about how visitors use the site, for example, what pages they visit frequently and if they are receiving error messages from web pages. These cookies collect aggregated, anonymous information that does not identify any visitor. They are used exclusively to improve the performance of a website.

4. TARGETING COOKIES

These cookies are used to deliver content that best suits you and your interests. It can be used to display targeted advertising / offers, limiting advertising projections or efficiency measuring an advertising campaign. These cookies do not recognize your individual identity.
